The attached layout shows Riverpark as Ragnar Relay intends arrange the finish line. We will have 2 security personnel outside of the beer tents where alcohol will be purchased and distributed to those 21 years or older. After an electronic ID check via scanner, those who are 21 years of age or older will be given a wristband so they may enter.

We will also have 4 Maricopa County uniformed sheriff deputies who are roaming both the outside and inside of the gated (connected bicycle gates) venue to insure no one takes the alcohol outside. The enclosed venue is designated on the layout as the black dotted line. The alcohol will be sold in the large orange tent designated with the letter B. Security and sheriffs are shown as the black dots both inside and outside the gates.

Please read A.R.S. § 4-203.02 Special event license; rules and R19-1-205 Requirements for a Special Event License.

Note: ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES MUST BE FOR CONSUMPTION AT THE EVENT SITE ONLY.



























A.R.S. § 41-1030. Invalidity of rules not made according to this chapter; prohibited agency action; prohibited acts by state employees; enforcement; notice

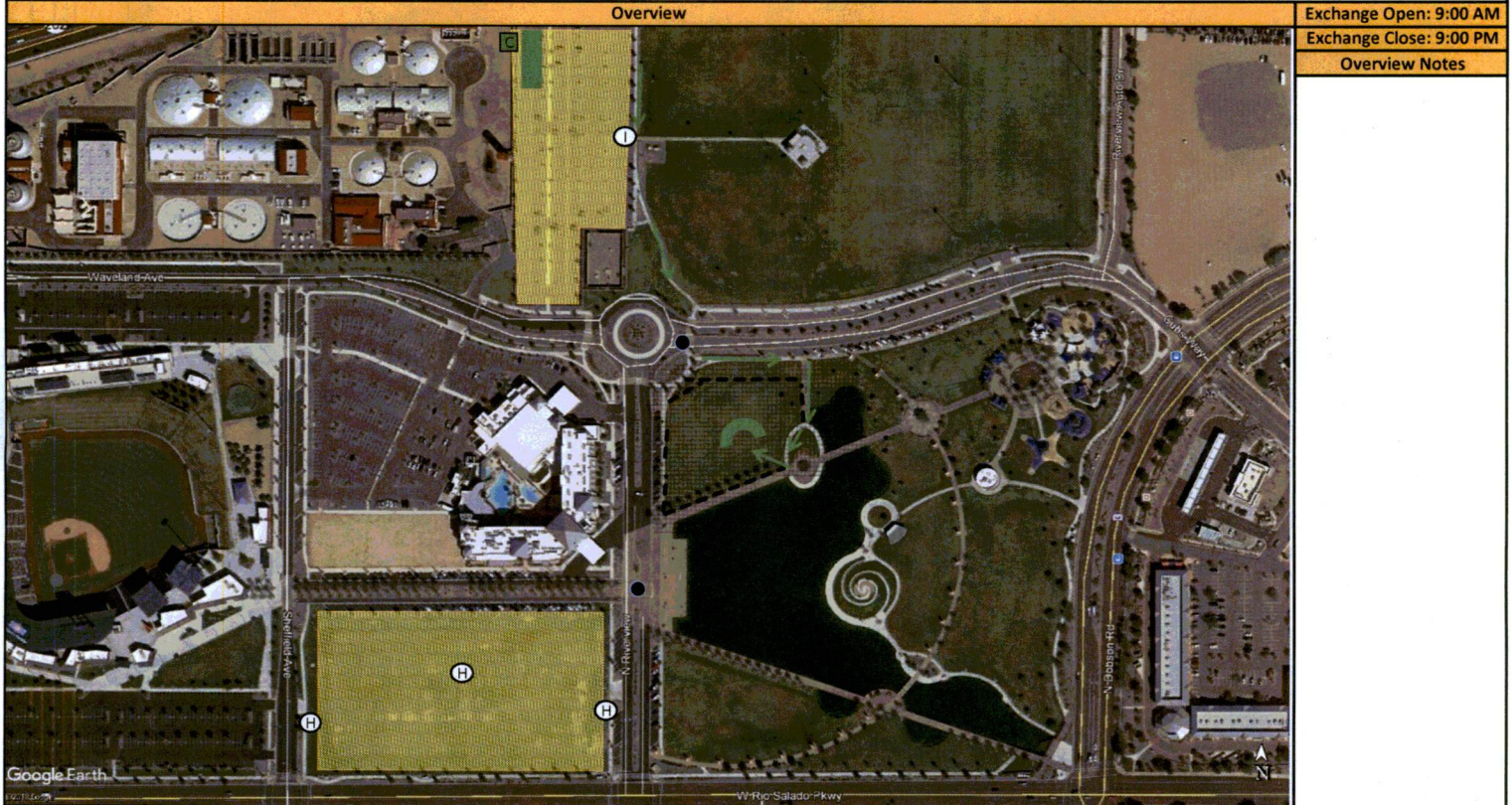

D. THIS SECTION MAY BE ENFORCED IN A PRIVATE CIVIL ACTION AND RELIEF MAY BE AWARDED AGAINST THE STATE. THE COURT MAY AWARD REASONABLE ATTORNEY FEES, DAMAGES AND ALL FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE LICENSE APPLICATION TO A PARTY THAT PREVAILS IN AN ACTION AGAINST THE STATE FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
