Subject: One-Year Renewal to the Term Contract for Urban Lake Maintenance for the

Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract renewal as recommended.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (PRCF) and Purchasing recommend authorizing the renewal contract with Aquatic Consulting & Testing, Inc. at \$34,601.50, based on estimated usage.

Background / Discussion

PRCF currently maintains and operates two urban fishery lakes and four community lakes including Riverview Park Lake, Red Mountain Lake, Dobson Ranch Lake, Carriage Lane Lake, Greenfield Park Lake and Eastmark Park Lake. This contract provides lake maintenance, water testing and analysis, mechanical equipment maintenance, fish management and chemical treatment for the City's six urban lakes. Cleaning, testing, and treatment procedures/protocols provided through this contract have helped in the early detection of golden algae, which has helped to minimize its impact.

Aquatic Consulting & Testing, Inc. agreed to renew the contract under the same terms, conditions and current pricing. The Consumer Price Index has increased by 5.5% over the last four years. In addition, this vendor's pricing is more than 10% lower than the next closet bidder. The City has been satisfied with the vendor's performance. This contract continues to be advantageous to the City and it is in the City's best interest to renew the contract.
