Subject:	2-Month Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Replacement Rotary Actuators and Parts for the Water Resources Department (Funded by the Utility Replacement Extension and Renewal Fund) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Water Resources Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the City of Tempe cooperative contract with Industrial Automation Services at \$50,000 annually with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide REXA rotary actuators and parts for the Southeast Water Reclamation Plant (SEWRP) aeration basins and some well sites.

The City of Tempe cooperative contract has been competitively bid and provides for the lowest possible cooperative pricing. Going out for a formal bid would only delay the purchase and would not result in any cost savings to the City.

Industrial Automation Services is the only authorized distributor of REXA actuators and parts in the state of Arizona.
