- 4. Affordable senior housing definitely needed in 85208. This company has much experience with LIHTC projects. Looks good criteria-wise
- 5. Seems like a qualified company to develop this project. Does not address large section of households in need of affordable housing, any family members under 55 years of age. Access to transportation services is very important.
