Subject: Purchase of Two Heavy-Duty Trucks with 8-Cubic Yard Asphalt Patch Bodies (Replacements) for the Transportation Department as requested by the Fleet Services Department **(Funded by the Local Streets Fund) (Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, RWC International LTD dba RWC Group at \$578,962.52.

Background / Discussion

Transportation needs to replace two, 8-cubic yard patch trucks that have frequent repairs, minimal payload capacity and no longer meet the needs of the Department. The two vehicles that are being replaced have met established criteria and will be either traded, auctioned, sold, or deployed to special uses as part of the ongoing vehicle replacement program.

The two replacement asphalt patch trucks will have double the payload capacity resulting in reduced trips to the asphalt plant while allowing field crews the ability to patch more utility cut repairs and fill more potholes during a workday.
