**Subject:** Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Aquatic

Maintenance Repair Parts for the Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities

Department (Citywide)

### Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidders: A&M Corsons; Aquatic Environmental Systems; and Diving Board Solutions, LLC; at \$45,000 annually, based in estimated usage.

## **Background / Discussion**

This contract will provide aquatic maintenance repair parts and new equipment for the eleven sites maintained by PRCF - Aquatics Maintenance. Parts and equipment include but is not limited to: Crystal Fountains, Vortex, Severn/Capital Controls, Aqua Creek ADA lift parts, Duraflex diving board parts and equipment, Myron L test equipment, ABB VFD's, ETS UV parts and equipment, Paragon deck equipment parts, parts and equipment from Pentair; Hayward; GEMS; Paco Pump; Mer-Made; Cla-Val; Asahi Valve; Spears Valve; and ChemKlor, Rimflow coping stones, and Pulsar chemical feeder parts and equipment, and Signet flowmeter parts and equipment.
