Action Plan: In order to provide effective citizen participation in conjunction with their application, the following actions will be taken place to provide opportunities to understand and address any real or perceived impacts their development that members of the community may have.

- 1. A contact list will be developed for citizens and agencies in this area including:
 - All registered neighborhood associations within one mile of the project.
 - Homeowners Associations within one half mile of the project.
 - Property owners within 1000 feet from the site.
- 2. All persons listed on the contact list will receive a letter describing the project, site plan and invitation to one neighborhood meeting to be at Pro Tax Financial Services at 761 S. Stapley Dr., Mesa AZ 85204.
 - The neighborhood meeting will be an introduction to the project, and opportunity to ask
 questions and state concerns. A sign-in list will be used and comment forms provided. Copies
 of the sign-in list and any comments will be given to the City of Mesa Planner assigned to this
 project.
