**Subject:** Three-Month Term Contract with a One Year Renewal Option for Irrigation

Controllers, Supplies, Maintenance and Repairs for the Parks, Recreation and

Community Facilities Department (Citywide)

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Buy Board Cooperative Purchasing cooperative contract with Interspec, LLC at \$500,000 for the initial three-month term, and \$500,000 annually for the renewal, with an annual increase allowance during the renewal term of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

## **Background / Discussion**

This contract will provide irrigation units and parts, supplies, maintenance and repairs for Motorola irrigation controllers.

The Buy Board Cooperative Purchasing contract will provide all required irrigation hardware and software (including Irrinet M units in master and slave configurations, Piccolo units, weather stations, and central control software ICC Pro 4). The cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the requirements of the City.
