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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY CITY OF MESA POLICE DEPARTMENT TO THE FORT MCDOWELL YAVAPAI NATION FOR PROPOSITION 202 FUNDS AND APPROVING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND ADMINSTER SUBSEQUENT AWARDED FUNDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Arizona's Indian Gaming Compact provides that an Indian Tribe make twelve percent (12%) of its net annual State contribution to cities, towns or counties for government services that benefit the general public. Private, not-for-profit organizations wishing to access Indian Gaming Funds ("Gaming Funds") to provide public benefits must secure sponsorship from a city, town or county before making application. This sponsorship must be expressed in a resolution passed by the local government sponsor.

<u>Section 2</u>: City of Mesa Police Department wishes to make application for \$70,000.00 from the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation for their Proposition 202 Grant Program. The \$70,000.00 will be used by City of Mesa Police Department for a Mobile Field Force Team transport vehicle.

<u>Section 3</u>: The City Council supports this grant request for funding.

<u>Section 4</u>: The City Council approves and authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation to accept awarded Gaming Funds.
