**Subject:** Purchase of Five Light-Duty Pickup Trucks (Replacements) for the Mesa Fire and Medical Department **(Funded by the Capital – General Fund)**  
**(Citywide)**

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase as recommended.

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase from the existing contract with Larry H Miller Ford Mesa (formerly Berge Ford) (a Mesa business) at \$36,831.33; and PFVT Motors, LLC dba Peoria Ford at \$180,679.84; for the combined total of \$217,511.17.

## Background / Discussion

The purchase is for one, F150, to be used as a scene response unit to fire and medical calls, and four, F250's, to be used as Battalion Chief response units.

The vehicles that are being replaced are part of the ongoing vehicle replacement program managed by Mesa Fire and Medical. These vehicles have met established criteria and will be either traded, auctioned, sold, or deployed to special uses.

All five vehicles are additional purchases from contracts Council previously awarded that allow for additional purchases.
