Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Pavement

Preservation Materials for the Transportation Department (Funded by the

Highway User Revenue Fund) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidders: Wright Asphalt Products Company, LLC; Quality Emulsions, LLC; Musgrove Enterprises, LLC dba SealMaster – Arizona; Guardtop, LLC; and Holbrook Asphalt, LLC; at \$2,735,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or based on the market indexes identified in the contract.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide pavement preservation materials per technical specifications for use by Transportation's in-house crews to maintain the City's roadways.

The Request for Bid solicitated bid responses for the products listed and mobilization by Groups (Group 1 – Terminal Blend Rubber Modified Emulsion; 2 – Emulsified Asphalt; 3 – Mastic Seal; 4 – Polymer Modified Asphalt Seal; 5 – Guardtop; 6 – High Density Mineral Bond; 7 – Liquidroad; 8 – Polymer Modified Binder (removed by addenda); 9 – Unique Pavement Materials; 10 – Guardtop LSTR; 11 – Optiseal; 12 – Qualityseal Plus; 13 – Optichip; and 14 – Optifog.

Awards are being recommended to the lowest, responsive and responsive bidders of each Group. None of the vendors bid Group 9 – Unique Pavement Materials.
