A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, TO PREPARE, SIGN AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO RECEIVE ENTITLEMENT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019/2020 UNDER THE NATIONAL AFFORDABLE HOUSING ACT OF 1990, AS AMENDED, TO FUND ACTIVITIES APPROVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND AUTHORIZING DISBURSEMENT OF PROGRAM FUNDS IF RECEIVED.

WHEREAS, the proposed activities to be undertaken were advertised and hearings held concerning the entitlement funds available and activities to be undertaken in fiscal year 2019/2020 under the HOME Investment Partnerships Program ("HOME") enacted as Title II of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 ("HOME Act"), as amended;

WHEREAS, the City Council was provided with recommendations of activities to be funded under the provisions of the HOME Act and approved all activities and funding allocations;

WHEREAS, a proposed statement of the projected use of funds was completed in accordance with federal requirements and made available to the public; and

WHEREAS, the proposed activities to be undertaken meet the objectives and priorities as identified in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to prepare, sign and submit applications, as well as any other necessary documents, to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for fiscal year 2019/2020 entitlement funds available to the City of Mesa under the HOME Act for activities approved by the City Council, and is authorized to disburse such program funds for the approved activities if received by the City.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to sign and submit any amendments, modifications, or revisions to the documents authorized by this Resolution, without the further consent of the City Council, provided all said amendments, modifications or revisions are in compliance with the funding recommendations of the City Council, the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan, the HOME program, and the HOME Act.
