Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase as recommended.

The Police Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase from the existing contract with PFVT Motors, LLC, dba Peoria Ford at \$37,581.23.

Background / Discussion

The vehicle that is being replaced is part of the ongoing vehicle replacement program managed by Fleet Services. The vehicle has met established criteria and will be either traded, auctioned, sold, or deployed to special uses.

The vehicle is an additional purchase from a contract Council previously awarded that allows for additional purchases.
