Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Corrosion Monitoring and Testing Services for the Water Resources Department
(Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

A committee representing the Water Resources Department and Purchasing evaluated responses. The evaluation committee recommends awarding the contract to the highest scored and qualified proposals from Accurate Corrosion Control, Inc.; and Peak Corrosion Control, Inc., at \$250,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide annual testing, inspection, maintenance and minor repair services for corrosion monitoring and cathodic protection systems within the City's water, reclaimed water and wastewater systems.

The City received two proposal responses, of which both met the minimum qualifications. A committee representing the Water Resources Department and Purchasing evaluated the responses and completed scoring of the responses against the evaluation criteria in the solicitation. Based upon the evaluation results and Best and Final offers, award is being recommended to Accurate Corrosion Control, Inc. (Primary); and Peak Corrosion Control, Inc. (Secondary). The evaluation committee unanimously agreed on the recommendation.
