Subject: Dollar Limit Increase to the Term Contract for Custodial Services for the Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract amendment as recommended.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department and Purchasing recommend increasing the dollar limit with Varsity Contractors dba Varsity Facility Services by \$30,187.02, from \$2,442,995.38 to \$2,473,182.40, for Year 5 of the term contract.

Background/ Discussion

This contract provides custodial services for City buildings. The contractor is responsible for providing personnel, insurance, transportation, supplies and tools of the trade to perform custodial cleaning tasks at City facilities on the scheduled days and frequencies as specified. These buildings house approximately 3,140 employees and 94,000 visitors per week. The City requires the contractor provide a high-level of customer service in a timely and professional manner using industry standards for custodial services.

The increase is needed for the addition of custodial services for the Parks Department at the Mesa Fire and Medical Regional Dispatch Center and Emergency Operations Center located 708 W. Baseline Road, Building 4, effective 7/1/2019.
