Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Hydraulic Hose and Fittings for the Fleet Services Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fleet Services Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Fleet Pride, Inc., (a Mesa business) at \$90,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide automotive and truck hydraulic hoses and fittings required for various pieces of the City's rolling stock and equipment.

Fleet Services specified Parker hoses and fittings primarily for two reasons: Excessive and increasing time, labor costs and loss of equipment use during hose repairs using another brand (Gates) hydraulic hose in previous years (December 2012 through July 2013); and the majority of the City's Solid Waste (Wayne and Heil brand) trucks come standard with Parker hydraulic hose and fittings (using non-Parker replacements may void vehicle warranty and result in increased in-house repairs due to premature hydraulic hose failures).

This contract will also provide various crimping machines and protective sleeves.
