Subject: One-Year Renewal to the Term Contract for Rigging and Over-Hire Stage

Hand Services for the Mesa Arts Center as requested by the Arts & Culture

Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract renewal as recommended.

The Arts & Culture Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the renewal with Rhino Arizona, LLC, at \$100,000 annually, based on estimated usage.

Background / Discussion

This vendor serves as the Mesa Art Center's in-house rigging provider and is responsible for fly-rail operations, weight loading operations, high rigging and low rigging. These services are required to perform certain aspects of theater operations.

Rhino Arizona LLC agreed to renew the contract at last year's pricing. The City has been satisfied with the vendor's quality service and trained staff. This contract continues to be advantageous to the City and it is in the City's best interest to renew the contract.
