Subject: Purchase of a Heavy Haul Truck (Replacement) for the Transportation Department as requested by the Fleet Services Department (**Funded by the Local Streets Fund**) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation and Fleet Services Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) cooperative contract with Inland Kenworth (U.S.), Inc., at \$179,529.35.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide a Kenworth truck that meets the Transportation Department's requirements and the City currently has five Kenworth trucks. As determined by Fleet Services, the Kenworth truck is the only heavy haul, low body transport that is capable and proven durability for hauling the Department's new Caterpillar PM312 cold planer and big equipment on a daily basis.

The vehicle that is being replaced has met established criteria and it will be retired from the fleet as part of the ongoing vehicle replacement program.

The NJPA contract was competitively bid, meets procurement requirements and prices are competitive due to nationally based volume contract pricing. It is unlikely that competitive bidding would result in better pricing than through this cooperative contract. City of Mesa is eligible to utilize this contract as a NJPA cooperative member.
