Subject: Purchase of a Light-Duty Cab and Chassis Vehicle (Replacement) for the

Transportation Department as requested by the Fleet Services Department

(Funded by the Local Streets Fund) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Transportation Departments and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with PFVT Motors, LLC dba Peoria Ford at \$60,840.89.

Background / Discussion

The purchase is for one, F550, 1.5-ton super cab truck with a 14' stake body and dual rear wheels. This vehicle will be utilized for the Transportation Department's graffiti abatement program. This truck has the capacity to carry all tools, equipment, and supplies for Transportation staff to abate graffiti throughout the City while meeting the Department's goal to abate graffiti within 24-hours or next business day.

The vehicle that is being replaced is part of the ongoing vehicle replacement program managed by Fleet Services. The vehicle has met established criteria and will be either traded, auctioned, sold, or deployed to special uses.
