RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT PROPOSITION 202 FUNDS FROM THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY AND ADMINSTER AWARDED FUNDS AS PASS-THROUGH GRANTS TO DESIGNATED AWARDEES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: Arizona's Indian Gaming Compact provides that an Indian Tribe make twelve percent (12%) of its net annual State contribution to cities, towns or counties for government services that benefit the general public. Private, not-for-profit organizations wishing to access Indian Gaming Funds ("Gaming Funds") to provide public benefits must secure sponsorship from a city, town or county before making application. This sponsorship must be expressed in a resolution passed by the local government sponsor.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Gila River Indian Community wishes the City of Mesa to receive and distribute \$210,900 from its 2019 12% revenues for grants as follows:

\$40,000.00 to Gene Lewis Boxing Club for their Building Hope Together program for youth.

\$30,000.00 to Mesa Arts Center for their Creative Aging program (2-year grant).

\$15,675.00 to House of Refuge for their Electrical Panel Replacement project.

\$15,225.00 to City of Mesa Police Department Crisis Response team for the Be Safe Certification and Community Engagement project.

\$10,000.00 to Vets' Community Connections for their Vets' Community Connections Services in Maricopa County.

\$100,000.00 to Save the Family Foundation of Arizona for their Rapid Re-Housing for Homeless Families program.

<u>Section 3</u>: The City Council supports these grants and authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to accept and administer the 2019 awarded Gila River Indian Community Proposition 202 funding.
