Subject: Purchase of a Mechanical PM-10 Street Sweeper with High Dump Capacity for the Transportation Department (Replacement) as requested by the Fleet Services Department **(Funded by the Local Streets Fund) (Citywide)**

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve a contract to purchase a new mechanical street sweeper with high capacity dump as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Transportation Departments, and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Freightliner of Arizona, LLC at \$269,954.92.

Background / Discussion

This contract is for the purchase of one, PM-10 mechanical street sweeper with 6-cubic yard dump capacity for Transportation - Field Operations. This sweeper is designed to support the asphalt milling, slurry seal, and fog seal operations conducted by the department's Asphalt Repair and Pavement Preservation work groups. This sweeper will help Transportation meet the demands of their in-house street maintenance program and comply with Maricopa County's PM-10 Rule 310 – Fugitive Dust from Dust-Generating Operations.

The vehicle that is being replaced has met established criteria and will be either traded, auctioned, sold, or deployed to special use as part of the ongoing vehicle replacement program.

This vehicle is an additional purchase from a contract Council previously awarded that allows for additional purchases.
