Subject:	Purchase of an X-Ray Kit for the Police Department (Sole Source) (Grant Funded by the Arizona Department of Homeland Security) (Citywide)

### Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Police Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase with Atlantic Diving Supply at \$36,704.89, based on estimated requirements.

### **Background / Discussion**

This purchase of a Nexray FPX Nano X-Ray Kit is for the Police Department's existing bomb unit. The new equipment is lightweight and versatile, can scan both small and large items down range and can be operated from a safe distance.

The department's Bomb Squad serves multiple cities including Gilbert, Apache Junction and Chandler and is considered a Regional Response Team for the Valley. The Valley's bomb community is relatively small, and squads often work together on large calls. It is extremely important that all the bomb teams in the Valley have the same equipment. The Nexray FPX Nano X-Ray Kit is the standard kit for the bomb squads in the Valley and most, if not all, the squads in the country.

Nexray is the sole manufacturer for the MSPT's FPX, MMX and HDX products. Atlantic Diving Supply is the sole distributer in the U.S. for these products.
