Subject: Purchase of a Rear Load Refuse Truck (Addition) for the Transportation Department as requested by the Fleet Services Department **(Funded by the Local Streets Fund) (Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Transportation Departments and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Freightliner of Arizona, LLC at \$194,286.86, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

This purchase of a new Freightliner M2106 18-Yard New Way Rear Load refuse vehicle will be utilized to support Transportation Field Operation's dedicated debris clean-up program. The citywide debris clean-up program was created as a result of a Council initiative. The rear loader is designed to hydraulically compact and store debris which will reduce trips to the landfill and increase productivity and will be operated by a two-person crew.

Using the State of Arizona cooperative contract for this purchase is advantageous to the City due to volume competitive pricing and the City has been satisfied with Freightliner's performance and products.
