A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A COMMUNICATIONS LICENSE WITH CROWN CASTLE FIBER LLC FOR AN INTIAL FIVE YEAR TERM WITH THE OPTION OF A FIVE-YEAR AUTOMATIC RENEWAL.

WHEREAS, Licensee has applied to the City for a License for the construction, installation, placement, operation and maintenance of an underground optical fiber based, communications network in, on, under, along, and across certain public streets, public rights-of-way, and public easements within the City in order to provide telecommunications services.

WHEREAS, Licensee intends to utilize its facilities to provide telecommunications services, and Licensee has obtained a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") from the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC");

WHEREAS, by such authority as may be conferred by Arizona Revised Statutes Sections 9-581 through 9-583 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, the Mesa City Charter, Mesa City Code, federal law, and other provisions of state law, the City wishes to issue a License to Crown Castle LLC; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The License between the City of Mesa and Crown Castle LLC, regarding the communication license is hereby approved,

Section 2: The Council of the City of Mesa hereby authorizes City Manager Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, to enter into the License and execute any other documents needed to implement this License on behalf of the City of Mesa, and authorizes the City Clerk to attest to the signature of the City Manager thereon.
