Subject: Dollar Limit Increase to the Five-Year Term Contract for Motorola and Kenwood Radio Equipment, Parts, Network and Services for the Mesa Fire and Medical Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract amendment as recommended.

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department and Purchasing recommend increasing the dollar limit using the State of Arizona and Maricopa County cooperative contracts with Motorola Solutions, Inc.; Durham Communications, Inc.; and JVCKenwood USA Corporation; by \$300,000, from \$400,000 to \$700,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

On December 9, 2019, Council approved this contract with the use of the aforementioned cooperative contract vendors for Information Technology - Communications to make purchases of Motorola and Kenwood equipment, repairs and services for various City Departments on an as-needed basis. This contract provides Motorola and Kenwood radios as another option for purchase and maintenance for City departments.

Mesa Fire and Medical (MFMD) will use this contract to purchase new radio equipment for new emergency response vehicles that are being purchased each year, and for additional equipment, repairs and services as needed.

Adding MFMD as a user department and the associated dollar limit increase will allow MFMD to utilize existing Motorola and Kenwood cooperative contracts for their equipment, repair and service needs.
