
Public Outreach in 2019

Mesa Moves: Survey Results


Most Important During Commute





Planned Transportation ProjectsALCP Discussion

- Proposition 400 sales tax sunsets December 31, 2025
- 70%/30% split between regional funding and local city funding
- Projects must be under construction by this time to receive reimbursement
- Proposed projects estimated to receive \$86.4M in reimbursements (may be more if project costs increase)
- Mesa currently has an additional \$44.4M of unallotted ALCP (\$42.1M in FY26)
