Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Traffic

Signal Controller Cabinets for the Transportation Department (Funded by the

Local Streets Fund) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidders: Sierra Transportation & Technologies, LLC; and Econolite (a Mesa business); at \$225,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Producer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will supply traffic signal cabinets for operation of signalized intersections per technical specifications. A traffic signal controller cabinet is an outdoor enclosure that contains the equipment necessary to provide safe and efficient traffic signal operation. The City specified Econolite: Model CAB14939, and Eagle Traffic Control Systems: Model CAB378-2101-330. These cabinets have been tested and approved by the City.

The City intends to award a Primary and Secondary vendor for this contract. The Primary vendor will provide traffic signal controller cabinets, based on the specifications. If the Primary vendor is unable to deliver the materials within the specified delivery time, the Secondary vendor will be contacted for the order and delivery of traffic signal controller cabinets.
