**Pre-Submittal Meeting**: The pre-submittal meeting with the City of Mesa planning staff was held on December 2, 2019. Staff reviewed the application and recommended the following:

All property owners within 1,000 feet of the proposed development be notified



- All registered neighborhood associations within 1 mile of the proposed development be notified
- All HOAs within ½ mile of the proposed development be notified
- Early outreach by Valvoline Instant Oil Change to the above parties

**Action Plan**: In order to provide effective citizen participation, the following actions will be taken to provide the community with opportunities to understand and address any real or perceived impacts from the proposed development.

- 1. A contact list will be developed for citizens and agencies in this area, including:
  - a. All property owners within 1,000 feet of the proposed development
  - b. All registered neighborhood associations within 1 mile of the proposed development
  - c. All HOAs within ½ mile of the proposed development
- 2. All persons on the above lists will receive a letter including the following:
  - a. Project Description
  - b. Site Plan
  - c. Building Elevations
  - d. Contact Information (as listed above for citizen outreach)
  - e. Invitation to the citizen participation meeting held at the Best Western Plus Mesa hotel (1563 S Gilbert Rd, Mesa, AZ 85204) on Thursday, March 19, 2020 at 7:00 pm.
- 3. The citizen participation meeting will provide an opportunity for citizens and agencies to learn about the proposed project, ask questions, raise concerns, and receive feedback. A sign-in list will be used and comment forms will be provided. A copy of the sign-in list and comments will be submitted to the City of Mesa (Attn: Charlotte Bridges, Planner I).
- 4. If there are an abundance of questions or concerns during the citizen participation meeting, the additional of a second citizen participation meeting will be considered. If a second meeting is held, Charlotte Bridges, Planner I, will be notified and secondary notifications will be sent to the parties listed above in point 1.
