Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Closed

Circuit Television Cameras (Replacement) for the Transportation Department

(Funded by Lifecycle Project Funds) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Koro BAS, Inc., at \$239,200 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

Transportation - Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) group currently operates over 200 closed-circuit televisions (CCTV) cameras that are used for real time monitoring traffic conditions. The oldest cameras are five (5) years past the typical life expectancy and need to be replaced.

This contract is for the replacement of existing cameras that are past their useful life expectancy and installation of new cameras at new locations as needed. Live images are used to monitor and manage traffic conditions in real time. Streams may also be shared with the Mesa Police Department for their use. Work will consist of but not be limited to: furnishing cameras and related parts (e.g. mounting hardware, cable, PoE midspan), installation/removal/replacement of cameras, installation/removal/replacement of cable (e.g. CAT5 shielded cable), and installation of wireless access points, etc.
