Historic Preservation Board – Seven-member board with one new appointment

<u>Louise Swann</u>, District 5. Ms. Swann is a business manager with over 30 years experience in accounting, payroll and human resources. In addition, she has experience serving on numerous community committees and organizations. Ms. Swann has also recently achieved City of Mesa Historic Landmark status for her home, the Ponderosa II. Ms. Swann's partial term will expire June 30, 2016.

Mesa Housing Authority Governing Board – Eight-member board with one reappointment

<u>William Egan</u>, District 2. Mr. Egan is a retired attorney with a bachelor's degree in business administration from Arizona State University and a juris doctor from the University of Arizona Law School. Mr. Egan served on the Flagstaff City Council during the 1970's. This will be Mr. Egan's tenth one-year term on the Mesa Housing Authority Governing Board. Mr. Egan's term will expire December 31, 2015.
