The City Council of the City of Mesa met in a Special Council Meeting in the Council Chambers, 57 East 1st Street, on January 15, 2015 at 7:32 a.m.

Mayor Giles excused Councilmember Finter from the entire meeting.

1. Election of Vice Mayor.

It was moved by Vice Mayor Glover, seconded by Councilmember Luna, to nominate Councilmember Kavanaugh as Vice Mayor for a one-year term, subject to the reappointment at the discretion of the Council in January of 2016.

Mayor Giles expressed support for the motion and stated that in 1996, he and Councilmember Kavanaugh were both elected to the City Council. He noted that Councilmember Kavanaugh is "on the cusp" of being the longest-serving Councilmember in the history of Mesa. He further commented that Councilmember Kavanaugh is a man of great wisdom, tenure and experience and added that he and his fellow Councilmembers are privileged to serve with him.

Mayor Giles called for the vote.

Mayor Giles declared the motion carried unanimously by those present.

Vice Mayor Kavanaugh thanked his colleagues for their support and said that he looked forward to serving as Vice Mayor.
