  - 3-a. Conduct a public hearing on a feasibility report for a proposed project to be financed by special assessment revenue bonds of the Cadence Community Facilities District Assessment District No. 1.

Approving the feasibility report for the acquisition and financing of improvements in the Cadence Community Facilities District; declaring its intention to acquire the improvements described in the feasibility report; forming Assessment District No. 1; determining that special assessment revenue bonds will be issued to finance the costs and expenses thereof; declaring the improvements to be of more than local or ordinary public benefit and that the costs of said improvements will be assessed upon Assessment District No. 1; and ordering the public infrastructure projects be acquired and performed in the Cadence Community Facilities District.

It was moved by Boardmember Thompson, seconded by Boardmember Luna, that Resolution No. CFD CD Res 7 be adopted.

Chairman Giles declared the motion carried unanimously by those present and Resolution No. CFD CD Res 7 adopted.

4-b. Approving an assessment diagram and the levying of an assessment within Cadence Community Facilities District – Assessment District No. 1.

It was moved by Boardmember Freeman, seconded by Boardmember Thompson, that Resolution No. CFD CD Res 8 be adopted.

Chairman Giles declared the motion carried unanimously by those present and Resolution No. CFD CD Res 8 adopted.
