September 6, 2018

The City Council of the City of Mesa met in a Study Session in the lower level meeting room of the Council Chambers, 57 East 1st Street, on September 6, 2018 at 7:30 a.m.

1. Review items on the agenda for the September 10, 2018 Regular Council meeting.

All of the items on the agenda were reviewed among Council and staff and the following was noted:

In response to a question posed by Councilmember Whittaker, Manager of Downtown Transformation Jeff McVay responded that funding for phase one of the downtown façade improvement project is covered, due to the fact that the new Request for Proposal (RFP) received more responses with costs in line with available funding.

City Manager Christopher Brady clarified that funding for the project had a minimal shortage, however, other Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project funding had excess funds which covered the shortage.

In response to a question from Councilmember Freeman, Mr. McVay stated that funding for the downtown façade improvement project is from CDBG and Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community grants, and no General Fund dollars will be used.

Discussion ensued relative to the history of the downtown façade improvement project.

In response to a question posed by Councilmember Thompson, Mr. McVay explained that the tenant matches 15% of the cost for the replacement of the façade.
