Resolution authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds, series 2020; approving the form and authorizing the execution and delivery of various documents related thereto; ratifying and approving a preliminary official statement and approving a final official statement relating to the bonds; levying an ad valorem tax on taxable property in the district; awarding the bonds to the purchaser thereof; appointing a registrar, transfer agent and paying agent for the bonds; and taking other actions securing the payment of and relating to the bonds. – CFD CD Res 34
