Transportation and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Arizona Department of Transportation contract with the sole source vendor, Pd' Programming, Inc., at \$26,400.00. This purchase is funded: 94.3% (\$23,575.00) by the Federal Highway Administration Grant, 5.7% City match (\$1,425.00) and Tax (\$1,400.00) by the Transportation Department operating budget.
