	<p>The increase is for the purchase and installation of an ultra-violet treatment (UV) system, a secondary water sanitizing system, for the splash pad at Riverview. A singular treatment system comprised of liquid chlorine is currently being used. Installation of the UV system will be performed prior to the summer, high-usage months.</p> <p>The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department and Purchasing recommend increasing the dollar-limit with A&amp;M Corsons; Aquatic Environmental Systems; and Diving Board Solutions, LLC; by \$45,000, from \$45,000 to \$90,000 annually, for Year 1 of the term contract, based on estimated requirements.</p>
