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Purchase of Eighteen Replacement Sports Utility Vehicles for the Police Department (Citywide)

The vehicles being replaced have met established criteria and will be retired and sold at auction. Midway Chevrolet currently has ten 2015 Tahoes on their lot for immediate purchase and the City will save over \$50,000 purchasing from dealer stock. The other eight Tahoes will be 2016 models, which will also be purchased from Midway Chevrolet, the State's contracted vendor for law enforcement vehicles.

The Fleet Services and Police Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Midway Chevrolet Nissan Isuzu, at \$743,182.37. This purchase is funded by the Vehicle Replacement Fund. (Note: The total cost per Police vehicle does not include up-fitting costs, which are contracted separately. Vehicle up-fitting for a Patrol Tahoe is \$15,906.00/each (LSH, contracted vendor, at \$14,700.00/each and Fleet Services, at \$1,206.00/each.))
