Dollar-Limit Increase to the One-Year Term Contract for Repair and Maintenance Parts for the Severn Trent Chlorine System for the Water Resources and Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Departments (Sole Source) (Citywide)

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (PRCF) has requested to be added to the contract, increasing the annual contract amount by \$40,000. PRCF uses Severn Trent equipment for water sanitation at their aquatic facilities, which is required to be compliant with Maricopa County regulations for public pool use.

Water Resources requires an increase of \$80,000 for the one-time replacement of obsolete injectors, including 70 injectors, nozzles and 25 preventative maintenance kits to be replaced within the next 6 months.

The Water Resources, and Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing a dollar-limit increase of \$120,000 with the sole source vendor, McCarthy Integrated Systems LLC, increasing the annual contract amount from \$120,000 to \$240,000 for the one-year contract term.
