One-Year Renewal with a One-Year Renewal Option to the Term Contract for Sludge Screen Machine Rental for the Water Resources Department (Citywide)

This contract provides the long-term rental of a sludge strain press unit at the Greenfield Water Reclamation Plant (GWRP). Phase III of the GWRP expansion project is still on-going and the permanent sludge press will not be installed and operational for at least six months. Water Resources will need to continue renting until such time the new machinery is operational.

The Water Resources Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the renewal with Huber Technology, Inc., at \$134,956.80, for a one-year term. This purchase is 58% funded by the Towns of Gilbert and Queen Creek and 42% funded by the Enterprise Fund - Greenfield WRP Joint Venture.
