Dollar-Limit Increase to the Term Contract for Landscape Maintenance Services for Parks, Retention Basins and Sports Fields (Zone 1) for the Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (Citywide)

This contract provides landscape maintenance services for sports fields, parkways, medians, parks, retention basins or grounds adjacent to City facilities. Tasks performed include cleaning, irrigation, sprinkler system maintenance, trimming, mowing, weed control, fertilization, etc. The increase is needed to add landscaping maintenance services for additional acreage at Basins 114, 115, and 116 in Zone 1; the Elliot Road Technology Corridor, the area between Power Road and Meridian Road.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department and Purchasing recommend increasing the dollar-limit with Mariposa Landscape Arizona, Inc., by \$28,367.47, for Zone 1, from \$1,435,319.57 to \$1,463,687.04 annually, based on estimated usage.
