Subject: Use of a Cooperative Contract for the Purchase of Six (6) Emergency Response Vehicles (Additions) for the Mesa Fire and Medical Department
(Funded by the Ambulance Transport Fund) (Citywide)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) cooperative contract with Professional Sales & Service, LC for \$2,225,565 including sales tax, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

Mesa Fire Medical Department (MFMD) is requesting the purchase of six, 2023 Horton Type 1 custom ambulance vehicles on Ford F-450 4X2 chassis. The new, emergency medical vehicles will provide life-saving transportation capabilities to the citizens of Mesa.

This purchase is in support of the transition to the City providing both Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Life Support (ALS) transport services. This purchase will increase the City's fleet to 28 vehicles.

The vendor currently estimates delivery 20-24 months after receipt of order.
