

RESOLUTION NO. 12328

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATIONS BY CITY OF MESA POLICE DEPARTMENT TO THE ARIZONA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2026 GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$324,000.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving and authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to apply for and enter into Highway Safety Contracts, and any related amendments or supplements thereto for Federal Fiscal Year 2026 grant funds with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety and to accept up to \$324,000 in grant funds. The Department is seeking funding for the following:

- \$140,000: Impaired and DUI funding for overtime, materials, and supplies.
- \$100,000: Police Traffic Services for overtime, materials, and supplies.
- \$ 41,000: Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety for overtime and supplies.
- \$ 20,000: Civilian Motorcycle Training for overtime and supplies.
- \$ 12,000: Accident Investigation for training and professional services.
- \$ 11,000: Occupant Protection for overtime, materials, and supplies.

Section 2: The City Council supports these grants and authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to apply for, accept and negotiate Highway Safety Contracts, and any related amendments or supplements thereto for FY 2026, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
