

RESOLUTION NO. 12445

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A WAIVER WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PURSUANT TO ARS § 28-7209, ALLOWING FOR THE VACATION OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC INTERCHANGES ALONG THE SUPERSTITION FREEWAY BETWEEN SOUTH CRISMON ROAD AND SOUTH SIGNAL BUTTE ROAD.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City of Mesa agrees to waive the four-year waiting period required for the vacation of State highways and roadways, allowing the Arizona Department of Transportation to proceed with the vacation of certain traffic interchanges along the Superstition Freeway between South Crismon Road and South Signal Butte Road, which will allow these rights of way to be transferred to the City of Mesa for continued public use.

Section 2: That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute the Waiver and take such actions and execute any other such documents as are necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest the signature of the City Manager, or his designated representative, thereon.
