## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the emergency purchase as recommended.

Parks Recreation and Community Facilities and Purchasing recommend ratifying the purchase from Metro Fire Equipment, Inc. at \$42,305.33.

## **Background / Discussion**

The contractor installed approximately 400 feet of FDC piping at the Centennial Parking Garage. During testing of the fire system, the original pipes were corroded and unable to hold water. Because of this, the fire system could not be turned back on resulting in a public safety issue. The system needs to be operational to meet City Fire Safety Codes.

The emergency purchase was approved by the City Manager's office as provided in the City Code.
