Subject: Purchase for the Climbing Net (Replacement) for the Genesis Tower at

Riverview Park as requested by the Parks, Recreation and Community

Facilities Department (Sole Source) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase from the sole source vendor, Dynamo Industries, at \$418,236.40, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide a full replacement of the climbing net which has reached end-of-life on the Dynamo Genesis XXXL DX-108. The net is for the iconic climbing tower at Riverview Park. The feature has become a favorite play element of the popular park and the net cannot be sufficiently replaced in smaller sections. The rope design has changed since the initial installation in 2013 and the expectation is that the new rope will have a longer life expectancy.

Dynamo Industries is the sole source for replacement and repair parts for all Dynamo playground equipment.
