## **RESOLUTION NO. 12260**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO ACCEPT AND ADMINISTER COMMUNITY PROJECT GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has made Community Project Grant funding available.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa applied for and was awarded \$1,000,000.00 in Community Project Grant Funding for its Desert Well Infrastructure Upgrades.

WHEREAS, the awarded federal funding for Desert Well Infrastructure Upgrades will support the development of Desert Well 24, which will serve as a backup water supply when Signal Butte Water Treatment Plant is down for maintenance, a canal outage, surface water shortage, or increased water demand.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representatives, is authorized to enter into the Community Project Grant Agreement for the Desert Well Infrastructure Upgrades with the United States Environmental Protection Agency and any related amendments, modifications, supplements, renewals, or extensions thereto.

Section 2: That the various City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all other acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
