**Subject:** Cooperative Contract Use for the Purchase of Two (2) Heavy-Duty

Construction Trucks with Dump Bodies (Additions) for the Transportation

Department (Funded by the Local Streets Fund) (Citywide)

### **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fleet Services and Transportation Departments and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the State of Arizona cooperative contract with Freightliner of Arizona, for \$601,189.62.

## **Background / Discussion**

The two (2) Freightliner dump trucks will be additions to Transportation's Field Operations fleet. One (1) truck will support the new concrete work group and the other truck will support the asphalt work group. The dump trucks have the capacity to haul material and heavy equipment to job sites. Additionally, these dump trucks will be required to respond to storm-related emergencies to deliver equipment, haul sand, and haul off debris.

The State of Arizona cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. Utilizing the State of Arizona contract allows the City to receive very competitive rates based on a formally solicited agreement. The City believes the cooperative pricing is fair and reasonable and soliciting for this product would not result in the City receiving more favorable pricing or terms. Freightliner confirmed they are only on the State of Arizona and Maricopa County contracts and pricing is the same for both contracts.
