

RESOLUTION NO. 12070

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CHANDLER RELATING TO HEAT RELIEF SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa (“Mesa”) and the City of Chandler (“Chandler”) applied jointly to Maricopa County and received a grant of \$600,000 in American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) funds to implement Heat Relief Services for individuals experiencing homelessness in Mesa and Chandler; and

WHEREAS, Chandler has agreed to service as the primary recipient of the ARPA funds to provide Heat Relief Services in Mesa and Chandler; and

WHEREAS, Mesa and Chandler jointly issued a Request for Proposals for comprehensive Heat Relief Services in each city, including day respite centers, cooling stations, mobile heat relief, and shower and laundry services, and have selected contractors to provide those services; and

WHEREAS, Chandler has agreed to enter into agreements with the selected contractors and serve as the contractor administrator and fiscal agent for Mesa in the performance of the contracts, and Mesa has agreed to monitor the provision of heat relief services in Mesa and will review and approve invoices for the services in Mesa; and

WHEREAS, Mesa and Chandler have the authority to enter into Intergovernmental Agreement relating to the provision of heat relief services pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-952.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1: Approving and authorizing and the City Manager, or designee, to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, with the City of Chandler relating to the provision of Heat Relief Services in Mesa and Chandler, including provision of day respite centers, cooling stations, mobile heat relief, and shower and laundry services.

Section 2: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Intergovernmental Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
