# The Rosetta Room Good Neighbor Policy

The Rosetta Room is committed to being a respectful and responsible member of the Downtown Mesa community. This Good Neighbor Policy outlines our measures to ensure ongoing compatibility with adjacent uses, maintain a safe and welcoming environment, and address any concerns promptly and effectively.

### **Sound Attenuation**

- Concerts and events will adhere to local noise ordinances, with all amplified sound ending by 11:00 PM.
- State-of-the-art soundproofing will be incorporated into the concert venue to minimize sound leakage.
- Outdoor events will use directional speakers and limit volume to reduce impact on neighboring properties.
- Live music will only be activated on the west side of the building, designated for concert venue use.

## Lighting Control Measures

- Outdoor lighting will be designed to minimize light spillover onto adjacent properties.
- All lighting fixtures will comply with local regulations, using shielded and downward-directed lights.
- Event-specific lighting will be limited to operational hours and dimmed or turned off promptly after events conclude.

## Vehicular Access and Traffic Control

- A formal agreement with First United Methodist Church will provide additional parking across the street, reducing street congestion.
- Clear signage will direct guests to designated parking areas.
- Event schedules will include staggered start and end times when possible to minimize traffic surges.

## **Complaint Response Procedures**

- All complaints will be documented, investigated within 48 hours, and addressed promptly.
- Remedial actions will be communicated back to the complainant, with follow-up to ensure resolution.

## Litter Control Measures

- Staff will conduct daily sweeps of the property and adjacent areas to remove litter.
- Trash receptacles will be strategically placed and regularly emptied during events.
- Post-event cleanups will be conducted to ensure the surrounding area is free of debris.
