RESOLUTION NO. 12327

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, ABANDONING THROUGH EXTINGUISHMENT A PORTION OF AN 8-FOOT PUBLIC UTILITIES EASEMENT LOCATED AT 4159 EAST FLOWER CIRCLE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Title 28 §§ 7201-7215 and/or Mesa City Code Title 9, Chapter 10, the City Council has the authority to abandon, vacate or extinguish (collectively, hereafter, "abandon") unnecessary roadway, right-of-way, or easements to which the City holds right or title to. Additionally, the City generally has the right to release restrictive covenants it holds on real property.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined a portion of the 8-foot PUE requested for extinguishment was dedicated on Lot 8 of Summer Mesa, recorded in Book 204 of Maps, Page 7, records of Maricopa County, Arizona, located at 4159 East Flower Circle, as hereafter described in **Exhibit A**, (Public Utilities Easement), is no longer needed.

WHEREAS Mesa City Code 9-10-2 permits the City Council to extinguish easements no longer needed by the City upon application and payment of the application fee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: All rights of the City of Mesa in and to a portion of the 8-foot public utilities easement described below are abandoned and deemed extinguished:
